To be eligible for online renewal, credentials must be within 6 months of expiration. Credentials expired for more than 6 months will require classroom renewal.

To participate in online renewal:

- Please visit flashtechnology.com/medium-intensity-renewal.
- Complete the form including the individual qualification numbers (IQNs) of all technicians at your company eligible for and wishing to complete their renewal online.
- Our training team will verify the expiration date of each technician's credentials against our database.
- After we verify eligibility, we will issue a formal quote. The online renewal fee is \$95 per technician.
- Once the quote has been signed and returned, we will send a URL for the online program.
- Distribute the link to your eligible technicians so that they may review the LED and/or xenon course materials and take the respective exams.
- Credentials will be issued via email after payment has been made and the exam(s) completed with a score of 80% or higher.

Payments are accepted via check or credit card. For security purposes, payment is not accepted via email.
